



# The Saint Isidore Student-to-Student Scholarship

The Saint Isidore Student-to-Student Scholarship was established in the spring of 2021 by the students and for the students as a part of the Saint Joseph's Catholic Academy Named Scholarship Program. This award is a student funded named scholarship that evolved out of an alms-giving initiative by students during the Lenten season in the spring of 2021. This named scholarship will continue to be funded through student giving initiatives. The amount of the award will be applied toward the student technology fee required by Saint Joseph's.

Saint Isidore, the Patron Saint of Students and Technology, founded schools and is a Saint who demonstrates exceptional life's work in each of our four pillars of Faith, Leadership, Scholarship, and Service.

## **Application Deadline**

Completed application must be received by either Ms. Mallett by 3:00pm on May 4th.

### **Scholarship Amount**

Two \$650.00 scholarships will be awarded to deserving candidates at our Academic & Arts Assembly in May. Recipients' attendance at this assembly is requested.

#### **Eligibility of Candidates**

Current Saint Joseph's students in 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, or 11<sup>th</sup> grade may apply for the Saint Isidore Student-to-Student Scholarship.

#### Criteria

Scholarships will be awarded based on a complete application that best demonstrates participation in each of the Four Pillars of Faith, Scholarship, Leadership, and Service. Applicants must submit a complete application that includes thorough responses. Applicants must demonstrate financial need as determined by the Business Office. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
