

WIFFLE BALL HOME RUN DERBY RULES

Round 1 - Participants are divided into groups.

Group placement is determined by random drawing.

- In this round, there are 10 outs.
- An out is classified as any swing of the bat that does not result in a home run.
 - Swing & miss,
 - Foul ball,
 - Ground ball,
 - Fly ball or
 - Line drive that does not clear the home run line/fence
- At the conclusion of the round, the top two home run totals from each group will advance to the next round of competition.
- In the event of a tie, a swing off will be held to determine who moves on.

Round 2 & Beyond - Single elimination, tournament style play is now in effect.

- Participants are seeded based on their home run total for round 1, if there are ties, the younger participant will be granted the higher seed.
- 10 outs for each participant per match up.
- An out is classified as any swing of the bat that does not result in a home run.
 - Swing & miss,
 - Foul ball,
 - Ground ball,
 - Fly ball or
 - Line drive that does not clear the home run line/fence
- In the event of a tie, a swing off will be held to determine who wins the matchup.
