St. Michael's Lent



What is it?

St. Michael's Lent is a devotion that dates back to the 13th century and was beloved by St. Francis of Assisi himself. Inspired by his love for both Our Lady and St. Michael the Archangel, Francis began keeping this forty day period of prayer and penance after receiving the stigmata on September 14, the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross.

When does it start?

St. Michael's Lent begins on August 15, the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and ends on September 29, the Feast of the Archangels. The final day, September 29, is also known as Michaelmas in many parts of Europe, especially in England and Ireland.

Why and how should I participate?

St. Michael's Lent, through sacrifice, helps us get closer to God. There are no strict rules, although most practices include praying daily, practicing penance through fasting or sacrifice, showing



daily, practicing penance through fasting or sacrifices, showing charity toward those in need, and attending Mass and Confession regularly.

Mr. Robbins will be participating in this devotion via the Hallow app, and invites those who are interested to reach out to do it with him.


